

TITLE: VETERANS ACCESS, CHOICE AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT, SEC, 702

Any individual using educational assistance under:

- Chapter 30 (Montgomery GI Bill ®– Active Duty Program),
 - Chapter 31 (Vocational Rehabilitation)
 - Chapter 33 (Post-9/11 GI Bill), of title 38, United States Code,
 - Chapter 35 (Survivors; and Dependents' Educational Assistance Program)
 - and/or the Marine Gunnery Sergeant John David Fry Scholarship (38 U.S.C. § 3311 (b)(9))
- Who lives in the State of Michigan while attending GOGEBIC COMMUNITY COLLEGE will be charged no more than the Out Of-District Rate (regardless of his/her formal state of residence).

Addendum:

Any covered individual can attend or participate in the course of education during the period beginning on the date on which the individual provides to Gogebic Community College a written request to use entitlement and a certificate of eligibility for entitlement to educational assistance under Chapter 31 or 33 (a “certificate of eligibility” can also include a “Statement of Benefits” obtained from the Department of Veterans Affairs’ VA website- eBenefits, or a VAF 28-1905 form for Chapter 31 authorization purposes).

Gogebic Community College will not impose any penalty to covered individuals that cannot meet his or her financial obligations to the institution due to the delayed disbursement funding from VA under Chapter 31 or 33.

- A Covered Individual is any individual who is entitled to educational assistance under Chapter 31, Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment, or Chapter 33, Post 9/11 Bill benefits
