

**TITLE: DEGREES AWARDED AND REQUIREMENTS**

The degrees awarded have specific general education requirements. The general education categories are defined as follows by Gogebic Community College:

Communications: Composition or Technical English, Speech.

Humanities: Western Civilization, Literature, Philosophy, Music, Art, and Drama. A number of applied courses in the Music, Art, and Drama fields do not count toward Humanities requirements. Advisors can assist with appropriate course selection.

Social Sciences: Political Science, Economics, Geography, Anthropology, Sociology, Psychology, and U.S. History.

Science and Mathematics: Computer Science, Biology, Anatomy, Physiology, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Geology, and Physical Science.

A cumulative grade point average of 2.00 or above is required for graduation with any certificate or degree.

A student must take at least 16 credits from Gogebic Community College to earn a degree and one half of the credits from Gogebic Community College for certificate programs.

To earn a second associate degree from Gogebic Community College, 15 non-duplicative credits are required.
