

**TITLE: INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS**

Gogebic Community College is a member of the National Junior College Athletic Association and Region XIII. GCC also offers men's and women's Nordic skiing, which competes in the Central Collegiate Ski Association. The intercollegiate athletic program provides inter-collegiate competition for eligible students in a variety of sports for women and men. The college competes with other two-year colleges in Upper Michigan, Wisconsin, Minnesota and North Dakota, as well as scheduling some events with four-year colleges and universities.

Students who participate in varsity athletics must meet NJCAA eligibility requirements. An athlete is allowed two years of competition in a community college per sport. If graduated at the end of two years, an athlete may transfer to most colleges and universities and be eligible immediately. Competition in a community college does not jeopardize future eligibility in a four-year college or university. Students who wish to compete in intercollegiate athletics should contact the Athletic Director.
