Men who are 18 through 25 years of age are required to register with Selective Service in order to be eligible for financial aid. The financial aid processing center checks with Selective Service to see if the students who must be registered are actually registered. If the match shows that the student isn't registered, the student must either register or provide evidence that he is registered or is exempt from registration.

The match that was performed on your data could not confirm your registration with Selective Service. Please complete this form and submit it along with the requested documents to the Financial Aid Office at Gogebic Community College.

_____ I am a noncitizen who entered the U.S. as a lawful nonimmigrant on a valid visa and remained in the U.S. on the terms of the visa until I turned 26.
